

Iida-machi, Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo - Land readjustment project

Location: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo

Development area: 5 ha

Services: Design services for roads, exteriors and bridges

In this land readjustment project for 5ha-area (approx.) including the Iida-machi freight station of the JR Freight Railway Company, the "Land readjustment" and the "District planning" were conducted at once, and it ended with a successful realization of the "Creation of abundant space" through the "Integration of public space and estate development area".

Specially, 300m-shopping mall offers the comfortable space as central district in this block.

A new access road was built along the Nihonbashi River near the east side of this area, and the sidewalk (4.5m) at the riverside to enhance the intimacy of water. The rebuilt Shinmisaki Bridge and the new pedestrian bridge (Aiai Bridge) help the easing of the pedestrian traffic congestion from the Suidobashi station. To enhance the anti-disaster function, the jetty was built at the revetment area of the Nihonbashi River established when building the access road.
